SATHA plans to organize the one day policy conference on **“Building Innovative Pakistan through Science, Technology and Innovation Policy”** on February 14, 2019, in Quaid-I-Azam University (Geo Auditorium), Islamabad. The conference is jointly organized by South Asia Triple Helix Association (SATHA), Pakistan-France Alumni Network (PFAN), Quaid-I-Azam University (QAU), University of Management and Technology (UMT), Pakistan Institute of Development Economics (PIDE), Ripah Institute of Public Policy (RIPP), Institute of Space Technology (IST), Mehran University Institute of Science and Technology Development (MUISTD), Eco Science Foundation (ECOSF) and other partners.

Pakistan’s exports stand at USD 20 billion and the per capita income is approximately USD 5,400. The countries that were behind Pakistan 2-3 decades ago, now stand at the export of USD 200-300 billion and per capita income levels of USD 20,000 to 30,000. The general attempts may reduce the gap little bit but in order to have leapfrog progress, Pakistan needs to address some fundamental issues like giving importance to science, technology and innovation. Pakistan may double its export to USD 30-40 billion export in the next few years. But to achieve USD 400 billion exports, Pakistan needs to revitalize its S&T base, supply innovation and innovate its education system.

In this regard, an annual policy conference on ‘Building an Innovative Pakistan’ through Science, Technology and Innovation is planned. The policy conference will share how to connect science with state and society, strengthen education and S&T organizations, increase export, generate employment and new economic activities, develop industries and achieve socio-economic development through science and technology initiatives.
