Authors are invited to elaborate on the role of individual Triple Helix actors and their relationships, shaping regional strategies, mobilising local and global networks with the focus on addressing specific challenges by designing place-based strategies and employing Triple Helix governance mechanisms.

Authors are invited to engage in a discussion on any of the issues relevant to this volume, such as: Mechanisms for Triple Helix engagement; Pathways to collaborative strategic planning; Barriers to regional development and innovation; Place-based strategies for sustainable development; Regional dimensions of knowledge exchange and the role of Universities; Regional innovation policies and the role of intermediaries.

Examples of Best Practice Triple Helix Cases are: demonstration of a genuine Triple Helix approach that reinforces efficient design and delivery of successful place-based and Smart Specialisation Strategies; original implementation of location specific innovation strategies and innovation policies that build resilience; successful examples of building triple helix coalitions for driving economic growth within regional boundaries; new and effective management of regional Triple Helix constellations of university-industry-government (U-I-G) partnerships, or other examples of a successful implementation of the Triple Helix model in practice.

The selection of the TOP 10 Best Practice Triple Helix Cases will be based on the quality of each case in terms of practitioner insights, original use of the Triple helix model, and the use of all sections of the template, including **Strategic Aims, Case Overview and Track Record, Tangible Impact, Intangible Impact, Transferability and Lessons Learned in Triple Helix Cooperation, and Bibliography**.
